Chief Master Sergeant John K. Elliott is the 172nd Airlift Wing Command Chief, Thompson Field, Jackson, Mississippi. As the Senior Enlisted Leader to the base commander, he is the key enlisted advocate and advisor on operational effectiveness to train and equip the Wing's enlisted Airmen. Chief Master Sgt. Elliott channels communications between the base commander and enlisted force to ensure the commander's directions, policies, and mission are understood and carried out. He works in concert with Group Superintendents and First Sergeants to oversee the professional development, readiness, training, health, morale, welfare, quality of life and proper utilization of assigned personnel.

In September 1991, Chief Elliott enlisted in the United States Air Force as a firefighter. He has held various roles throughout his career, from that of Firefighter, Emergency Medical Technician, Senior Fire Instructor, Special Agent, Chief of Training, President of the Mississippi Fire Chiefs Association, the Mississippi Firefighters Minimum Standards and Certification Board, and Fire Chief. He has served in numerous civilian and military leadership functions within the fire service career field and has deployed in support of Operation's Desert Shield, Storm, Provide Promise, Deny Flight, Sea Signal, Southern



Watch, Enduring Freedom, Noble Eagle, New Dawn, Inherent Resolve, and Freedom Sentinel. Prior to assuming his current position, Chief Master Sgt. Elliott served as the 172nd Mission Support Group Superintendent. In this position, he worked with the Command Chief, Group Superintendents, and First Sergeants to oversee the readiness, training, health, morale, welfare and quality of more than 450 assigned personnel across six squadrons and flights, including Force Support, Civil Engineering, Security Forces, Logistic Readiness, Communications and a Special Operations Civil Engineer Squadron gained by Air Force Special Operations Command.
