CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT JOHN W. MYERS

Chief Master Sergeant John W. Myers is the 172d Airlift Wing Command Chief, Thompson Field, Jackson, Mississippi. As the Senior Enlisted Leader to the base commander, he is the key enlisted advocate and advisor on operational effectiveness to train and equip the Wing's enlisted Airmen. Chief Myers channels communications between the base commander and enlisted force to ensure the commander's directions, policies, and mission are understood and carried out. He works in concert with Group Superintendents and First Sergeants to oversee the professional development, readiness, training, health, morale, welfare, quality of life and proper utilization of assigned personnel.

In 1991, Chief Myers enlisted in the United States Navy as a Petty Officer 2nd Class, Yeoman for his first enlistment. After a short break in service, he joined the Naval Reserve Center, Meridian, Mississippi as a Petty Officer 3rd Class, Yeoman in 1999. Then Chief Myers transferred to the Mississippi Air National Guard in 2001 where he trained as an Air Transportation Specialist for the 172d Aerial Port Squadron, Thompson Field, Jackson, Mississippi. In 2008, he became the First Sergeant for the 172d Logistic Readines Squadron. Four years later, Chief Myers served as 172d Airlift Wing's First Sergeant, advocating and mentoring the wing's 1,200 members, as well as advisor to the Wing Commander and Unit Commanders on the professional development, military readiness, health, morale, and welfare of assigned enlisted



personnel. As the chair of the Wing's First Sergeants Council and the First Sergeant liaison to the Wing's Chief Council, he ensured the wing's senior enlisted force was united in the Wing Command Chief's vision. Additionally, he balanced leadership and guidance of the command's 13 First Sergeants while representing the enlisted force at various military and civilian speaking engagements.

Prior to this assignment, Chief Myers served as the 172d Maintenance Group Superintendent. In this position, he served as the commander's senior enlisted leader for operational effectiveness and organization, training and equipping approximately 300 enlisted Airmen with specific focus on professional development of Senior Noncommissioned Officers. Chief Myers worked in concert with the Command Chief, Group Superintendents and First Sergeants to oversee the readiness, training, health, morale, welfare and quality of life of assigned personnel. In addition, Chief Myers served as the 172d AW Chiefs Council President and Chair of the 172d AW Community Action Team.
